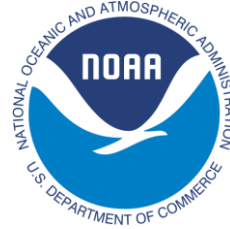


B-WET Upper Susquehanna Project OUTDOOR Training – May 14, 2016
